BURIAL FEES – APRIL 2021

Grant of Exclusive Right:

For the Exclusive Right of Burial in a site for up to 75 years
6'6" x 3' £600

For the Exclusive Right of Burial of Cremated Remains in the designated
Cremation area for up to 75 years £280

Administration:

A child whose age did not exceed one month £50
A child whose age exceeded one month but not 16 years £60
A person whose age at the time of death exceeded 16 years £100

Transfer of Exclusive Right of Burial £80

Permits for Memorials, Gravestones and Tablets:

A flat stone not exceeding 6ft 6in x 3ft £150
A headstone not exceeding 4ft in height £120
A kerbstone enclosing a space not exceeding 6ft 6in x 3ft £150
A vase or tablet not exceeding 18in £80

The fees indicated above include the first inscription
For each additional inscription £80

Gravedigging Charges:

Cremated remains – single depth £180
Cremated remains – double depth £200
Full burial - single depth £450
Full burial - double depth grave £500

Memorial Plaque for the Memorial Wall:

Memorial Plaque £150
Memorial Plaque with photo £200
Reservation of Brick space £75

The above fees apply to a person who was a parishioner of Pembury at the time of death. The fees will be doubled where the deceased did not live in Pembury. If the deceased had only moved to Pembury to go into a Care Home this will not be counted as being a resident.
